As universal fit lift truck buckets slip onto the blades directly, they stay on the equipment and are much less susceptible to damage. These buckets are even fifty percent deeper compared to the quick-tach bucket models. This additional room makes them perfect for lifting irregular shaped loads such as backfilling behind walls, tearing off roof trash, elevating roof gravel, moving large debris piles and broken up concrete.
